WALES


Baner Cymru or Y Ddraig Goch, meaning 'the red dragon of Cadwallader'

Dragon from Celtic Mythology/Welsh Folklore is named Dewi (Welsh for David) after the patron saint of Wales. Western dragons can fly. Eastern dragons are snake-like.

Union Jack – Part of Commonwealth Southern Cross in Southern Hemisphere = North Star in Northern Hemisphere navigation

Union Jack – Part of Commonwealth Federation/Commonwealth Star Southern Cross in Southern Hemisphere = North Star in Northern Hemisphere navigation



CANADA

"Maple Leaf" = cultural heritage & natural resources red = hope and prosperity white = peace and neutrality





SPAIN

1st European country to use red & yellow – probably so warships could be identified in battle

According to legend = tradition of bullfighting red = blood spilled by the bulls (hardiness, strength and bravery) yellow = the sand in the arena (generosity)




GREECE

I Galanólefki "blue and white" or the Kyanólefki "sky blue and white" (


Nine equal alternating horizontal blue and white stripes representing seawater and white wave crests.


DENMARK

SWEDEN


Nordic Cross/Scandinavian Cross = Christianity Flag design shows shared history. blue = justice loyalty, truth, vigilance and perseve

Oregon state flag also 2-sided



ARGENTINA


Manuel Belgrano (leader of the Argentinian revolution against Spain)

blue sky parting reveals white clouds = Liberation Star of May = May demonstrations




BRAZIL

Verde e amarela ("The Green and Yellow") or Auriverde ("The Gold-Green") Green = lush fields and forests, yellow = gold, celestial orb features southern cross, translation = order and progress




SOUTH KOREA

Taegukgi =, unification, creation, light and eternity white rectangular background = peace & purity, a red (positive cosmic forces) and blue (opposing negative cosmic forces) Taegeuk in center = balance in the universe, and four black trigrams one toward each corner = movement and harmony




JAPAN


PANAMA

Red = china, white = equality and democracy, blue =
liberty and nationalism. red, white, and blue = three core
principles of the country
sun = twelve rays = twelve months





UNITED STATES OF AMERICA


Stars & Stripes or Star-Spangled Banner 50 Stars = 50 States Red = hardiness and valour, white = purity and innocence, and blue = vigilance, perseverance and justice.

13 Stripes = Founder Colonies Red, White & Blue = Democracy

Double pennon - only non-quadrilateral flag blue = peace, red = rhododendron = official flower crimson red crescent moon = royal house, sun = Rana family




CHINA

Wu Xing Hang Qi (Five-Star-Flag)

Red = communist revolution, also the traditional colour of the people

five stars in relation = unity of Chinese people under the leadership of the Communist Party of China (large gold star = communism & four smaller stars = social classes Chinese people (the workers, the peasants, the urban bourgeoisie, the national bourgeoisie)

five stars represent ethnic groups: Han Chinese, Zhuangs, Hui Chinese, Manchus and Uyghurs



BHUTAN

Eastern dragons are snake-like. Western dragons can fly. Thunder Dragon, from mythology = Druk Yul, holding mythical jewel Norbu


Yellow = civil traditions, white = purity and loyalty, orange = Bhuddist spiritualism

TURKEY


Ay Yıldız "moon star" - national anthem refers to Alsancak (red banner)

Symbol of Ottoman Empire before Islamic – according to legend the reflection of the moon and star appeared in the pools of blood during the battle of Kosovo in 1448 when the Ottomans defeated the Christian forces.




TURKMENISTAN

crescent moon = Islam, five stars = five provinces of the country, red stripe containing five carpet designs = five original tribes

1977 old flag = green field = Gaddafi's promise of green revolution

Since 2011 brought back pre-1969 flag after liberation

red = Fezzan region

black = Cyrenaica region

green = Tripolitania region

crescent = Islam




IRAQ

Since 2008

Stars removed from takbīr (Allahu akbar, "God is [the] greatest") in green Kufic script

red = willingness to shed blood, green = Islam, black = battles, white = purity of deeds



SAUDI ARABIA

green field = favourite colour of the Prophet
Muhammad most associated with Islam
Shahada or Muslim creed "There is no god but God;
Muhammad is the Messenger of God" written in Thuluth
script

in white above a horizontal sword



IRAN

green = Islam; white = peace, red = courage. symbol = five principles of Islam Takbir written in white Kufic script repeated 11 times each



INDIA

Tiraṅgā = Tricolour Saffron = courage and sacrifice White = represents peace, unity and truth Green stands for faith and fertility

Blue = sky and water

Ashok Chakra = Wheel of Law has 24 spokes and it stands for progress



SOMALIA

Calanka Soomaaliyaa field = United Nations blue five-pointed white = "Star of Unity" = Somali Race Djibouti, Ethiopia, Kenya former British and Italian colonies.




MOROCCO

red = hardiness, bravery, strength and valour, green = love, joy, wisdom, peace and hope; also the colour of Islam pentagram = Seal of Solomon, also five pillars of Islam



GHANA

red = blood spilled during struggle for independence from Great Britain, gold = mineral wealth green = forests and natural wealth black star is the symbol of African emancipation

yellow star =independence = bright future.

Nguni shield covering two spears and a staff decorated with feather tassels = protection from enemies




traditional hat (mokorotlo) = Basotho cultural heritage

Central African Republic Seychelles Comoros Namibia use five colours in their flag bird =National Emblem of Zimbabwe


white triangle = peace & "way forward".

red = fight for independence



REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

Dominica parrot = only other 6 coloured flag - not as clear. Originally no meanings, typical African flag = y-design and colours reminiscent of other examples on continent. black, yellow and green = ANC, red, white and blue = colonial rule by Netherlands & Brittain, y-design = a merging of the past and the present.

With time cultural diversity and then more traditional associations were made -

Yellow = Mineral Riches
